A lot of research is done on young people but not by them. The Young Researcher Network (YRN) wants to change this, by supporting young peoples' led research. The YRN, formed by the NYA in 2007, brings together 14 partners who over the last year have been working together with groups of young people to conduct research on a range of issues. The YRN has supported this work with research skills training and a grants programme. The research work can be grouped under three themes, positive activities, identity and representation and health and social care. With young people setting the research agenda the specific areas that have been researched include, volunteering, disability, looked after young people, alcohol use, the media, hate crime and restorative justice, health, the local youth offer and identity.
